2021 BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL

Application Due Date: March 1, 2021

Payment Due Date: May 31, 2021

Dear Occoquan Business Owner:

It is time to renew your Business and Professional Occupational License with the Town for 2021. Business license renewal forms are due no later than March 1, 2021. A penalty of 10% may be added if your application is received after March 31, 2021, and/or a 10% penalty will be added if your payment is received after May 31, 2021.

The business license fee is based on gross receipts for calendar year 2020; however, the minimum fee is \$30.00. The application shall, in all cases, be signed personally by the person who authenticates the federal income tax returns for the business, profession, trade or occupation. This signature constitutes a sworn statement from the applicant as to the amount of gross. All applications are subject to verification by the State of Virginia Department of Taxation.

Restaurants must attach a copy of their current Health Department Certificate with their application. If the Commonwealth of Virginia issues a license in connection with your business or profession, a copy of the State License must be attached to your application.

Please complete the enclosed application and note any corrections. Checks should be payable to the Town of Occoquan. The business license will be mailed to you and must be displayed in a public area of your business.

You may submit your renewal to Town Hall, located at 314 Mill St., from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday, or mail to Town of Occoquan, P.O. Box 195, Occoquan, VA 22125. If you have any questions, please contact me at (703) 491-1918 or mcasillas@occoquanva.gov.
