2023 VEHICLE LICENSE FEE DUE NOVEMBER 15

Your 2023 Vehicle License Fee for all vehicles garaged in the Town of Occoquan is due November 15, 2022. Town Ordinance Section 71-02 requires that owners of any motor vehicle principally garaged, stored, or parked in Town pay an annual Vehicle License Fee. Upon payment, a decal is issued for each vehicle as proof of payment; the decal is not a parking sticker. **The 2023 decal must be displayed on your vehicle by November 16, 2022.**

Please complete and submit a registration form. Please be sure to complete the reverse side of the form and include your signature and contact information. Residents may purchase 2023 vehicle decals in person or by mail.

For your convenience, Town Hall will be open late on Tuesday, November 1, until 6:30 p.m. for vehicle license purchases. Please note that any change of ownership (automobiles, motorcycles, boats, campers, trailers, RVs) should be reported to Prince William County at 703-792-6710 within 30 days.

The Town does not collect personal property tax; residents are required to file and pay such taxes to Prince William County. Visit pwcva.gov for more information on personal property taxes.
